- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize certain children who are subject to a pending
- 2 military relocation to apply for enrollment in a school district.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-28 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, a child meets the residency requirement
- 6 for school attendance in a school district if the parent or guardian of the child is transferred to
- 7 or is pending transfer to a military installation within the state while on active military duty
- 8 pursuant to an official military order. A school district shall accept an application for enrollment
- 9 and course registration by electronic means for any child who meets the requirements in this
- section, including enrollment in a specific school or program within the school district.
- The parent or guardian of a child who meets the requirements in this section shall provide
- 12 proof of residence to the school district within ten days after the arrival date provided on the
- enrollment application. As proof of residence for the purposes of this Act, the parent or guardian

- 1 may use the address of any of the following:
- 2 (1) A temporary on-base lodging facility;
- 3 (2) A purchased or leased home or apartment; or
- 4 (3) Any federal government housing or off-base military housing, including off-base
- 5 military housing that may be provided through a public-private venture.
- 6 For the purposes of this section, a military installation is a base, camp, post, station, yard,
- 7 center, or other installation under the jurisdiction of the United States Department of Defense.
