- 6 sale, transfer, ownership, manufacture, or repair of firearms or ammunition or their components.
- Any ordinances ordinance prohibited by this section are is null and void. The attorney general
- 8 shall bring an action in the name of the state for injunctive relief against any county that has
- 9 passed an ordinance in violation of this section. A court shall grant any person charged with a
- 10 violation of an ordinance prohibited under this section reasonable costs, expenses, and attorney's
- 11 fees.

- municipality that has passed an ordinance in violation of this section. A court shall grant any
- person charged with a violation of an ordinance prohibited under this section reasonable costs,
