- $1 \qquad \hbox{An Act to authorize the designation of Purple Star schools.}$
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

4	13	3-53E-3. Purple Star schoolDesignationRules.
5		The secretary of education may designate a school as a Purple Star school if:
6	(1)	The school designates a staff member to serve as a military liaison and directs the
7		<u>liaison to:</u>
8		(a) Identify military-connected students enrolled in the school; and
9		(b) Serve as a point of contact between the school, community-based support
10		services, and military-connected students and their families;
11	(2)	The school provides on its website:
12		(a) The contact information for the military liaison;
13		(b) Information regarding relocation, enrollment, and record transfers between
14		schools for military-connected students;
15		(c) Information regarding academic planning for military-connected students,
16		including course sequences and the availability of advanced placement
17		courses;
18		(d) Information regarding counseling, mentoring, volunteering, support
19		services, and other programs for military-connected students; and
20		(e) Information regarding the interstate compact on educational opportunity
21		for military children, as set forth in chapter 13-53E;
22	<u>(3)</u>	The school implements, with the assistance of other students, a program to assist
23		military-connected students in transitioning to the school;
24	<u>(4)</u>	The school provides staff development opportunities related to issues and
25		challenges faced by military-connected students; and
26	(5)	The school:

1	(a) Recognizes and celebrates the month of the military child; or
2	(b) Provides opportunities for military personnel, including veterans, to
3	volunteer at the school, speak at an assembly, provide virtual
4	presentations, or host a field trip.
5	The department of education shall promulgate rules, in accordance with chapter 1-
6	26, to establish the manner in which a school may apply for designation as a purple star
7	school and establish the process, including the statewide rubric, by which the application
8	is to be reviewed and eligibility for the designation determined.
9	For purposes of this section, a military-connected student is a student who is
10	enrolled in an elementary or high school or receiving early childhood services from a school
11	or school district, and either has or had a parent on active duty, on reserve duty, or in the
12	National Guard.
