- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to permit an order changing the name of a minor child
- 2 without prior publication in certain instances.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 21-37 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 The court may grant an order changing the name of a minor child without publication of
- 6 notice or a hearing in open court if all of the following conditions are met:
- 7 (1) It appears from the pleadings that the minor child has been a resident of the county
- 8 in which the petition is filed for at least six months;
- 9 (2) The minor child's parents whose parental rights have not been terminated, and any
- 10 other person having legal rights to custody or guardianship of the minor child, give
- 11 written consent to the name change;
- 12 (3) The minor child, if twelve years of age or older, gives written consent to the name13 change; and
- 14 (4) It appears to the court that the name change is in the minor child's best interests.
