## HOUSE BILL NO. 1062

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt from alcoholic beverage regulations certain uses
- 2 of alcohol by postsecondary institutions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 35-1 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 Under this section, the term, postsecondary institution, means any post secondary institution,
- 6 technical institute, or private college or university located within the state.
- A postsecondary institution may produce and store up to two hundred gallons or less of
- 8 distilled spirits, malt beverage, or wine each year for the purposes of research and offering bona
- 9 fide educational courses instructing students in the production of distilled spirits, malt beverage,
- or wine products. A postsecondary institution is not deemed a manufacturer or a retailer under
- 11 this title.
- The production and storage of alcohol under this section is exempt from any license required
- by this title or any tax or fee imposed by this title. Any distilled spirits, malt beverage or wine
- product produced under this section may not be sold or offered for sale.

- 1 No person under age twenty-one may be a student in a course offered under this section nor
- 2 may any person under age twenty-one consume distilled spirits, malt beverage, or wine
- 3 produced under this section.
