# House Bill 1064

### HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS ENGROSSED

Introduced by: Representative Milstead

An Act to make an appropriation for and the establishment of peer support and critical incident stress management training for first responder organizations.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:
- 6 **34-54-1. Heroes wellness grant.**
- 7 <u>The Department of Public Safety shall establish and administer the heroes wellness</u> 8 grant. Funds shall be expended as appropriated by the Legislature.
  - **Section 2.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

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# 10 **34-54-2.** Grant--Oversight--Purposes.

All moneys for the heroes wellness grant shall be used and expended under the direction of the secretary of public safety. The secretary shall provide grants to eligible applicants for the purpose of creating, establishing, and developing first responder peer support programs and first responder critical incident stress management programs within the state. Grants shall be provided for training programs that are, or are similar to those, developed by the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation, Inc. First responders, whether volunteer or professional, include any member of a:

- (1) Law enforcement organization;
- (2) Fire suppression organization;
- 20 (3) Emergency medical service, including emergency medical technicians and paramedics; and
- 22 (4) An organization providing emergency dispatch services to any organization listed in this section.
- 24 **Section 3.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

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# 34-54-3. Application--Review--Criteria--Promulgation of rules.

An applicant shall submit an application to the secretary on a form prescribed by the secretary. The secretary shall, by rules promulgated pursuant to chapter 1-26, develop administrative procedures regarding the application and grant award process including any scoring system to be used to evaluate or rank applications. The secretary shall act as fiscal agent for the grant and shall be responsible for receiving and reviewing grant applications and awarding grants under this chapter. The secretary shall give consideration to regions within the state that may have more significant need.

At least thirty days before the first day applications may be submitted each fiscal year, the secretary shall publish on the office's website the specific criteria and any scoring system used to evaluate or rank applications and award grants under this chapter. The commissioner shall also post any unserved or underserved areas that are eligible for grant funding.

#### **Section 4.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

# 34-54-4. Application--Contents.

An applicant for a grant under this section shall provide the following information on the application:

18 (1) The location of the project;

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- 19 (2) The proposed training:
- 20 (3) The number of personnel to be trained;
- 21 (4) The total cost of the training and associated expenses; and
- 22 (5) Any additional information requested by the secretary.

## 23 **Section 5.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

## 24 **34-54-5. Grant funds--Use.**

Grant funds may be used for:

- (1) Costs and expenses associated with hosting and coordinating an eligible training;
- (2) Per diem for food and lodging, at the rate established under § 3-9-2, for each full day a person provides or participates in a training funded under this grant; and
- 29 (3) Mileage, at the rate established under § 3-9-1, to and from the training for each person that provides or participates in a training funded under this grant.
- 31 **Section 6.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$200,000, to the
- 32 <u>Department of Public Safety, for the purposes of creating an endowment to provide ongoing</u>

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- 1 moneys for the heroes wellness grant, to be called the South Dakota Heroes Wellness
- 2 endowment, held in trust and vested with the South Dakota Community Foundation, and
- 3 <u>administered by the Department of Public Safety.</u>
- 4 **Section 7.** The funds appropriated in section 7 of this Act shall be transferred to the South
- 5 <u>Dakota Community Foundation to fund the South Dakota Heroes Wellness endowment, to be</u>
- 6 <u>administered in accordance with the provisions of this Act.</u>
- 7 **Section 8.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$50,000 to the
- 8 <u>Department of Public Safety, for the heroes wellness grant.</u>
- 9 **Section 9.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 10 revert, in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 11 **Section 10.** The secretary of the Department of Public Safety shall approve vouchers and the
- 12 <u>state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.</u>
