- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow student midwives to practice the functions of a
- 2 nurse practitioner or nurse midwife in certain instances.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 36-9A-3 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 36-9A-3. This chapter does not prohibit the performance of the functions of a nurse
- 6 practitioner or nurse midwife by an unlicensed person if performed:
- 7 (1) In an emergency situation;
- 8 (2) By a legally qualified person from another state employed by the United States
- 9 government and performing the person's official duties in this state;
- 10 (3) By a person enrolled in an approved program for the preparation of nurse
- practitioners or nurse midwives, as a part of that approved program; or
- 12 (4) By a certified professional midwife student during clinical training and under the
- direct supervision of a preceptor who has met the preceptor criteria established by the
- North American Registry of Midwives and is licensed in South Dakota under chapter
