- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require students in grades one and two to be tested before
- 2 being promoted to the next grade.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-3 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Each elementary school shall annually assess each student in grade one and grade two to
- 7 measure the level of each student's achievement to determine if the student should be promoted
- 8 to the next grade. If the assessment indicates that the student is not proficient in the areas
- 9 assessed, the student may not be promoted to the next grade.
