HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS ENGROSSED

- An Act to create the Center for American Exceptionalism at Black Hills State
 University, make an appropriation therefor, and declare an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-59 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

5		The Board of Regents shall establish the Center for American Exceptionalism at		
6	<u>Black</u>	Hills State University. The center shall make the state's public universities		
7	<u>contri</u>	outing, meaningful, and relevant partners in civics and social studies education by:		
8	(1)	Working in conjunction with classroom teachers who, by training and experience,		
9		are familiar with civics and social studies curricular development, to create,		
10		distribute, and annually update a kindergarten through grade twelve curriculum		
11		that:		
12		(a) Is available to all public school districts;		
13		(b) Pertains to American history and exceptionalism;		
14		(c) Explains why America rose to greatness and how to keep it that way;		
15		(d) Teaches students to balance critical thinking with love of country; and		
16		(e) Includes a South Dakota history and American Indian tribes component that		
17		focuses on the proud history of the indigenous peoples of this state;		
18	<u>(2)</u>	Providing multi-media content, speaking directly to state social studies standards;		
19	<u>(3)</u>	Developing and offering to elementary and high school teachers professional		
20		development opportunities, to help students:		
21		(a) Understand American history, government institutions, constitutional		
22		rights, and cultural contexts in this state and beyond;		
23		(b) Develop personal agency and confidence to participate in the civic life of the		
24		state and nation through voting, volunteerism, informed discourse, and		
25		lifelong involvement; and		

1		(c) Appreciate civil discourse, free speech, and engagem	<u>ent with people of all</u>		
2		perspectives;			
3	<u>(4)</u>	(4) Promote existing programs and develop and implement new programs to help			
4		students, throughout this state, become actively engaged cit	<u>izens; and</u>		
5	(5) Develop, implement, and annually update a curriculum, that is available to be				
6		taught in two courses, at the state's public colleges and ur	iversities, and which		
7	consists of:				
8		(a) A course comparing communist and socialist country	ries to Western-style		
9		democratic countries throughout history; and			
10		(b) A course comparing command-style socialist econo	mies to free-market		
11		capitalist economies throughout history.			
12	Section	. That chapter 13-59 be amended with a NEW SECTION	:		
13		An advisory board, appointed by the president of Black Hills S	State University, shall		
14	provide recommendations and direction to the Center for American Exceptionalism and				
15	may seek all available sources of funding.				
16	On or before February first of each year, and at other times as it may deem in the				
17	public interest, the Center for American Exceptionalism shall report, to legislative				
18	committees having jurisdiction over education, with respect to its operations in the				
19	previo	us fiscal year.			
20	Section	There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sui	m of \$150,000 to the		
21	Board of Regents for the purpose of establishing the Center for American Exceptionalism, as				
22	set forth in this Act.				
23	Section	- The executive director of the Board of Regents shall appro	ove vouchers and the		
24	state aud	or shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this	s Act.		
25	Section	. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expend	ed or obligated shall		
26	revert in	ccordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.			
27	Section	Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state	government and its		
28	existing p	ublic institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, a	nd this Act shall be in		
29	full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
