1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions relating to the salaries and per 2 diem of county commissioners. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 7-7-5 be amended to read as follows: 5 7-7-5. The board of county commissioners may determine the salary of the commissioners. 6 Such salary may be set by the board of county commissioners at its first regular meeting of each 7 year. If the board of county commissioners fails to determine a salary, then the salary of a county 8 commissioner in any one year is: 9 Seven thousand two hundred thirty-three dollars as per diem or salary in counties of **(1)** 10 thirty thousand population or over: 11 (2) Six thousand five hundred sixty-six dollars as per diem or salary in counties of fifteen 12 thousand population and over and not more than thirty thousand population; 13 Five thousand three hundred ninety-seven dollars as per diem or salary in counties (3) 14 of eight thousand population and over and not more than fifteen thousand population; Four thousand eight hundred ninety-six dollars as per diem or salary in counties of 15 **(4)**

- less than eight thousand population.
- 2 However, no board of county commissioners may set their salary at a sum that is more than
- 3 the minimum salary provided for in this section plus an additional fifty percent.
- 4 Section 2. That chapter 7-7 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 In addition to any salary and per diem paid to any county commissioner pursuant to this
- 7 chapter, any board of county commissioners may grant the chair of their board a monthly stipend
- 8 of not more than one hundred dollars to compensate the chair for the extra time and duties upon
- 9 the position of chair.
