- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for limits on certain out-of-state contributions
- 2 to ballot question committees.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 Contributions to a statewide ballot question committee from a person who is not a resident
- of the state at the time of any contribution, a political committee that is organized in a state other
- 7 than South Dakota, or any other organization that is not filed as a domestic entity with the
- 8 secretary of state for the four years preceding a contribution may not exceed one hundred
- 9 thousand dollars in the aggregate for a general election cycle. For purposes of this section, a
- 10 general election cycle, means the period that includes the day after the general election held in
- November of an even-numbered year through the day of the general election held in November
- in the following even-numbered year, inclusive.
- All committees established, financed, maintained, or controlled by the same corporation,

- labor organization, person, group of persons, and any parent, subsidiary, branch, division,
- 2 department, or local unit of any corporation, labor organization, person, or group of persons are
- 3 affiliated and share a single contribution limit under this section.
