## HOUSE BILL NO. 1077

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require parental approval to waive a school counselor 2 privilege regarding a student under sixteen. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 19-13-21.1 be amended to read as follows: 5 19-13-21.1. No counselor or school psychologist, certificated in accordance with the 6 certification regulations of the South Dakota Board of Education and regularly employed as 7 counselor or school psychologist for a private or public elementary or secondary school or 8 school system in the State of South Dakota, may divulge to any other person, or be examined 9 concerning any information or communication given to the counselor or school psychologist in 10 the counselor's or school psychologist's official capacity by a student unless: 11 (1) This privilege is waived in writing by the student a parent or legal guardian of any 12 student under the age of sixteen years or by the student if the student is sixteen years 13 of age or older; or 14 (2) The information or communication was made to the counselor or school psychologist 15 for the express purpose of being communicated or of being made public; or

1 (3) The counselor or school psychologist has reason to suspect, as a result of that
2 information or communication, that the student or some other persons have been
3 subjected to child abuse or that the student's physical or mental health or the physical
4 or mental health of other persons may be in jeopardy.
