# House Bill 1077

#### **HOUSE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENGROSSED**

Introduced by: Representative Mulally

- 1 An Act to require certain language for the oath or affirmation for civil office.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

## Section 1. That § 3-1-5 be AMENDED:

**3-1-5.** Every person elected or appointed to any civil office shall, before entering upon the duties thereof, qualify by taking an oath or affirmation to support the Constitution of the United States and of this state, and faithfully to discharge the duties of his office, naming it to support the Constitution of the United States and of this state, with language nearly identical to the oath provided in S.D. Const., Art. III, § 8, as is applicable to the office; and by giving a bond, when one is required, conditioned that he the person will faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of his the office, naming it, and render a true account of all money, credits, accounts, and public personal property requiring inventory, as defined in rules issued by the commissioner of the bureau of administration, that shall come into his the person's hands as such officer, and pay over and deliver the same according to law.

### Section 2. That § 13-8-14 be AMENDED:

**13-8-14.** The newly elected members of the school board shall qualify and assume membership at the annual meeting of the school board in July, and appointed members at the next meeting following such appointment, by taking and subscribing to an oath or affirmation, as provided in § 3-1-5, to support the laws and Constitution of the United States and the State of South Dakota and to faithfully perform the duties of school board membership and by filing a bond if required by law and having it approved.
