- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the removal of
- 2 security freezes.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 54-15-11 be amended to read:
- 5 54-15-11. A security freeze remains <u>under § 54-15-4 shall remain</u> in place until the earlier
- 6 of the date the consumer reporting agency receives a request from the consumer to remove the
- 7 freeze or until seven years from the date that the security freeze was put in place pursuant to
- 8 § 54-15-4. A consumer reporting agency shall remove a security freeze within three business
- 9 days of receiving a request for removal from the consumer, who provides both of the following.
- 10 If making a request under this section, a consumer shall provide to the consumer reporting
- 11 <u>agency</u>:
- 12 (1) Proper identification, as defined in subdivision 54-15-6(1); and
- 13 (2) The unique personal identification number or password provided by the consumer
