- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require that crematories be under the direction of
 licensed funeral establishments and funeral directors.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 34-26A-3 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 34-26A-3. Any resident of this state, or any cemetery, funeral establishment, corporation,
- 6 partnership, joint venture, voluntary organization, or any other entity may erect, maintain, and
- 7 conduct operate a crematory in this state and provide the necessary appliances and facilities for

8 the cremation of human remains in accordance with this chapter. The operation of any crematory

- 9 in this state shall be under the direction and supervision of a licensed funeral director and a
- 10 licensed funeral establishment, each licensed pursuant to chapter 36-19. A crematory shall
- 11 conform with all local building codes and environmental standards, and it may be constructed
- 12 on, or adjacent to, any cemetery, on or adjacent to any funeral establishment that is zoned
- 13 commercial or industrial, or at any other location consistent with local zoning regulations.
- 14 Section 2. That § 34-26A-41 be amended to read as follows:
- 15 34-26A-41. A crematory authority may employ a licensed funeral director for the purpose



2 and processing all necessary paperwork. No provision of this chapter may be construed to

- 3 require a licensed funeral director to perform any functions not otherwise required by law to be
- 4 performed by a licensed funeral director.
