- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit a person from interfering with a public safety
- 2 answering point.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 22-34-28 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 22-34-28. Any person who, by any means, knowingly damages or, tampers, or interferes
- 6 with any property or service and, as a direct result:
- 7 (1) Causes a substantial interruption or impairment: in television, radio, telephone,
- 8 telegraph, or other mass communications service; in police, fire, <u>public safety</u>
- 9 answering point as defined by § 34-45-1, or other public service communications; in
- radar, radio, or other electronic aids to air or marine navigation or communications;
- or in amateur or citizens band radio communications being used for public service
- or emergency communications; or

1 (2) Causes a substantial interruption or impairment in public transportation, water

2 supply, gas, power, or other utility service;

3 is guilty of a Class 6 felony.
