- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal provisions regarding certain disclosures on
- 2 campaign communications.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 12-27-15 be repealed.
- 5 <u>12-27-15. Any printed material or communication made, purchased, paid for, or authorized</u>
- 6 by a candidate or political committee that disseminates information concerning a candidate,
- 7 public office holder, ballot question, or political party shall prominently display or clearly speak
- 8 the statement: "Paid for by (name of candidate or political committee)." This section does not
- 9 apply to buttons, balloons, pins, pens, matchbooks, clothing, or similar small items upon which
- 10 the inclusion of the statement would be impracticable. A violation of this section is a Class 2
- 11 misdemeanor. A subsequent offense within a calendar year is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
