

## 2021 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1103

## 1 An Act to authorize the State-Tribal Relations Committee to issue subpoenas.

- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

4	2-6-23.1. State-Tribal Relations CommitteeStudy authoritySubpoenas.
5	The State-Tribal Relations Committee may examine all records and summon
6	witnesses by request or by issuing a subpoena whenever the record or witness is
7	necessary for the committee to fulfill its responsibility to study the relationship between
8	the state and its political subdivisions and the tribes and their tribal governments. The
9	committee may issue a subpoena for the person, documents, or both, and use the
10	procedure provided in chapter 21-34 to enforce its subpoena when the subject of the
11	subpoena refuses to comply with the command to appear and testify before the
12	<u>committee.</u>
13	No subpoena may be issued until the decision to issue a subpoena by the
14	committee has been ratified by the Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council.
15	Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added:
16	2-6-23.2. State-Tribal Relations CommitteeSubpoenaCriteria.
17	Before a subpoena may be issued by the State-Tribal Relations Committee, the
18	committee shall determine all of the following:
19	(1) A legislative purpose exists pursuant to §§ 2-6-23 and 2-6-23.1;
20	(2) The subpoenaed person or documents are relevant and material to accomplish the
21	legislative purpose; and
22	(3) The information sought is not otherwise practically available.
23	It is not a legislative purpose to subpoena a person or documents to collect
24	information that may be used for a criminal proceeding or to legislatively determine guilt
25	or inflict punishment upon an identifiable person.
