2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

- 3 Section 1. That § 9-43-86 be amended to read:
- 4 9-43-86. Twenty days after publication of the adopted resolution of necessity, unless the
- 5 referendum is invoked or unless a written protest is filed with the finance officer signed by the
- 6 owners of more than fifty-five percent of the frontage of the property to be assessed, the
- 7 governing body may cause the local improvement to be made, may contract for the
- 8 improvement, and may levy and collect special assessments as provided in this chapter. Upon
- 9 a two-thirds vote of the governing body, a protest petition may be denied and the governing
- 10 body may cause the local improvement to be made.
