## HOUSE BILL NO. 1105

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase the energy minerals severance tax and to deposit
- 2 the additional revenue in the education enhancement trust fund.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 10-39A-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 10-39A-1. For the privilege of severing energy minerals in this state, there is imposed on the
- 6 owner or operator of any energy mineral an excise tax, to be termed a "severance tax," equal to
- 7 four and one-half <u>nine</u> percent of the taxable value of any energy minerals severed and saved
- 8 by or for the owner or operator.
- 9 Section 2. That § 10-39A-8 be amended to read as follows:
- 10 10-39A-8. All taxes, interest and penalties imposed and collected by the secretary of revenue
- 11 under this chapter shall be distributed as follows:
- 12 (1) One-half Twenty-five percent shall be returned to the county in which the energy
- minerals or mineral products were severed;
- 14 (2) One-half share Twenty-five percent shall be paid into the state treasury and credited

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- 1 to the general fund; and
- 2 (3) Fifty percent shall be paid into the education enhancement trust fund as provided in
- 3 <u>S.D. Const., Art. XII, § 6</u>.
