1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding
2 restraint of trade.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 37-1-15 be repealed.

5 ~~— 37-1-15. Whenever any suit in equity is brought in any court under this chapter wherein the~~
6 ~~state is complainant, the attorney general or the state's attorney may file with the clerk of such~~
7 ~~court a certificate that in his opinion the case is of general public importance, a copy of which~~
8 ~~shall be immediately furnished by such clerk to the judge of the court in which said case is~~
9 ~~pending. Thereupon such case shall be given precedence over others and in every way expedited~~
10 ~~and be assigned for hearing on the earliest practicable day.~~

11 Section 2. That § 37-1-16 be repealed.

12 ~~— 37-1-16. All laws, rules, and regulations relative to applications for and granting of orders~~
13 ~~of injunction in force in this state shall apply to proceedings under the provisions of this chapter~~
14 ~~so far as the same are not in conflict with the provisions of this chapter.~~

15 Section 3. That § 37-1-17 be repealed.



1 ~~— 37-1-17. Whenever it shall appear to the court before which any civil or criminal proceeding~~
2 ~~under this chapter shall be pending, that the ends of justice require that other parties shall be~~
3 ~~brought before the court, the court may cause them to be summoned whether they reside in the~~
4 ~~county where the court is held or not.~~
