- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate funding for the purpose of a one-time 2 increase in state aid to education. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of twelve million two 5 hundred twenty-two thousand ninety-six dollars (\$12,222,096), or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, to the Department of Education for the purpose of a one-time payment to school 7 districts. 8 Section 2. After July 1, 2011, the secretary of the Department of Education shall distribute 9 the funds, on a one-time basis, appropriated by section 1 of this Act to school districts based on 10 fall enrollment as defined in subdivision 13-13-10.1(2A) at the same time that foundation 11 program state aid is distributed to school districts pursuant to §§ 13-13-10.1 to 13-13-41, 12 inclusive. 13 Section 3. The secretary of the Department of Education shall approve vouchers and the
- 14 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
