- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit the use of certain public resources to influence
- 2 the outcome of elections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 12-27-20 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 12-27-20. The state, an agency of the state, and the governing body of a county,
- 6 municipality, or other political subdivision of the state may not expend or permit the
- 7 expenditure of public funds or permit the usage of its telecommunications systems, electronic
- 8 <u>devices, office equipment, office supplies, postage, or vehicles</u> for the purpose of influencing
- 9 the nomination or election of any candidate, or for the petitioning of a ballot question on the
- 10 ballot or the adoption or defeat of any ballot question. This section may not be construed to limit
- the freedom of speech of any officer or employee of the state or such political subdivisions in
- 12 his or her personal capacity. This section does not prohibit the use of public facilities and
- 13 equipment for forums or debates. This section does not prohibit the state, its agencies, or the
- 14 governing body of any political subdivision of the state from presenting factual information
