- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit the use of tanning devices by minors.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 4 Terms used in this Act mean:
- 5 (1) "Tanning device," equipment that emits electromagnetic radiation having
- 6 wavelengths in the air between two hundred and four hundred nanometers and that
- 7 is used for tanning human skin. The term does not include a phototherapy device
- 8 used by a physician licensed pursuant to chapter 36-4 that emits ultraviolet radiation
- 9 and is used in treating disease;
- 10 (2) "Tanning facility," a business that provides persons access to a tanning device.
- 11 Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- No person may permit a minor to use a tanning device at a tanning facility. A violation of
- this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
