- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal the requirement that rear vehicle registration
- 2 plates be illuminated.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 32-17-11 be repealed.
- 5 32-17-11. Either the rear lamps required by § 32-17-8 or a separate lamp shall be so
- 6 constructed and placed as to illuminate with a white light the rear registration plate and render
- 7 it clearly legible from a distance of fifty feet to the rear. If the rear registration plate is
- 8 illuminated by an electric lamp other than the required rear lamps, the lamps shall be turned on
- 9 or off only by the same control switch at all times whenever headlamps are lighted. A violation
- 10 of this section is a petty offense.
