Every person who, at the time of an election, has been a resident of this state who 6 shall be of the age of for at least thirty days prior to the election, is eighteen years and upwards 7 of age or older, is not otherwise disqualified, who shall have complied and complies with the 8 provisions of law relating to the regarding registration of voters shall be entitled to may vote at 9 any election in this state. 10 Section 2. That § 12-1-4 be amended to read: 11 12-1-4. For the purposes of this title, the term, residence, means the place in which a person 12 has fixed his or her habitation and to which the person, whenever absent, intends to return. 13 A person who has left home and gone into another state or territory or county of this state 14 for a temporary purpose only has not changed his or her residence. 15 A person is considered to have gained a residence in any county or municipality of this state

- 1 in which the person actually lives, if the person has no present intention of leaving.
- 2 If a person moves to another state, or to any of the other territories, with the intention of
- 3 making it his or her permanent home, the person thereby loses residence in this state voting, a
- 4 qualified elector may have only one residence, shown by an actual fixed permanent dwelling,
- 5 establishment, or any other abode to which the person returns when not called elsewhere for
- 6 <u>labor or other special or temporary purposes.</u> A qualified elector retains a residence in this state
- 7 until another residence has been gained.
