- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make a minor's school calendar the reference point from
- which to permit employment that would not interfere with the minor's education.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 60-12-2 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 60-12-2. No child under fourteen years of age may be employed at any time in any factory
- 6 or workshop or about any mine, nor be employed in any mercantile establishment except during
- 7 hours when public schools are the child's own school or other educational program is not in
- 8 session and in no case after seven o'clock p.m. Violation of this section is a Class 2
- 9 misdemeanor.
- Section 2. That chapter 60-12 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 11 follows:
- As used in this chapter, a school day is any day on which the child's own school or other
- educational program is operating and the child is expected to attend. A school week is a week
- during which the child's own school or other educational program is operating and the child is
