- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish a tribal flag display on the capitol grounds.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That chapter 5-15 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 4 The official flag of each of the nine federally recognized Indian tribes in this state shall be
- 5 displayed in a suitable place on the capitol grounds to be determined by the commission.
- The Legislature shall hold a ceremony open to the public to honor and recognize the flag
- 7 display during each legislative session and representation from each branch of state government
- 8 and from each tribe with a flag on display shall be invited to participate.
