- 2 ceremony.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-1-66 be amended to read:
- 5 13-1-66. The state, any of its political subdivisions, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof
- 6 shall of municipalities may not prohibit any person from wearing traditional tribal regalia or
- 7 objects of cultural significance or from the singing of an honor song at a school honoring or
- 8 graduation ceremony. For purposes of this section the term, tribal regalia or object of cultural
- 9 significance, means an eagle feather or, an eagle plume, or a beaded graduation cap.
