1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for drug testing for certain TANF recipients.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. The Department of Social Services may develop and implement a random drug 4 screening program to test any adult recipient who is eligible for temporary assistance for needy 5 families cash benefits. Any recipient who is found to have tested positive for the use of a 6 controlled substance that was not prescribed for the recipient by a licensed health care provider 7 may become ineligible to receive benefits for a period of one year and the person shall be 8 referred for appropriate professional or agency assistance. However, any aggrieved recipient is 9 entitled to an administrative hearing to determine the validity of the test and to contest the 10 decision to suspend the benefits.
