- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the penalty for aggravated assault with the intent
- 2 to disfigure the victim.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 22-18 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 Any person, who assaults another with the intent to cause serious permanent disfigurement
- 6 and causes serious permanent disfigurement, is guilty of a Class 2 felony.
- 7 Assault with intent to cause serious permanent disfigurement as set forth in this section may
- 8 be charged in the alternative as aggravated assault, as set forth in § 22-18-1.1.
