HOUSE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES ENGROSSED

- 1 An Act to create a registration requirement for sober living homes.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added to title 34:
- For purposes of this chapter, the term, sober living home, means any dwelling in which:
 - (1) An alcohol-free or drug-free housing environment is maintained for unrelated individuals recovering from substance use disorders; and
 - (2) Persons are provided with one or more methods of treatment for substance use disorders, ranging from recovery housing to clinical treatment.
 - The term does not include an accredited prevention or treatment facility, as defined in § 34-20A-2.

12 Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added to title 34:

- Each sober living home must be registered with the Department of Social Services.

 The registration is valid for one year and may be issued only upon a showing that the home is in compliance with local building codes and zoning requirements, and maintained and operated in accordance with the following provisions:
 - (1) That any person residing in a sober living home that provides medication-assisted treatment may receive the treatment, subject to adequate security being provided for any medications;
- 20 (2) That the sober living home develops and enforces rules to maintain an alcohol and
 21 drug-free environment, with an exception for prescribed or over-the-counter drugs
 22 that are taken as directed;
 - (3) That any complaints received by a municipality regarding the sober living home are addressed in accordance with applicable ordinances;
- 25 (4) That the owner or operator of a sober living home maintains:

1		(a) Up-to-date emergency contact information for each person residing in the
2		home;
3		(b) A list of each person's medications; and
4		(c) In the case of a clinical treatment sober living home, a description of each
5		person's medical condition;
6	<u>(5)</u>	That all persons residing in the sober living home are informed of the applicable
7		rules and policies and that the rules and policies are posted in a conspicuous place
8		within the home;
9	<u>(6)</u>	That a complaint procedure for the use of persons residing in the home is developed
10		and posted in a conspicuous place within the home; and
11	<u>(7)</u>	That single or multi-station smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors, and fire
12		extinguishers are installed and maintained, in accordance with local ordinances.
13	Section 3	3. That a NEW SECTION be added to title 34:
14		The Department of Social Services shall maintain, on its website, a list of registered
15	sober	living homes.
16		Neither a state agency nor a contracted vendor may refer a person to a sober living
17	home	unless that home is registered, as required by section 2 of this Act.
18		State funds may not be expended in support of any sober living home, unless that
19	home	is registered, as required by section 2 of this Act.
20		No home may hold itself out to be a sober living home or accept residents for
21	purpos	ses of sober living unless that home is registered, as required by section 2 of this
22	Act.
