- 2 day decision petitions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-26-9 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 13-26-9. A decision by a school board to schedule the opening day of classes before the first
- 6 Tuesday following the first Monday in September may be referred to a vote of the qualified
- 7 voters of the school district by the filing of a petition signed by five percent of the registered
- 8 voters in the school district, based upon the total number of registered voters voting at the last
- 9 preceding general election. The board in scheduling the opening day of classes shall allow
- sufficient time for the referendum process authorized in this section.
