- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain provisions providing for a pilot charter
- 2 school for Native American students if the state had received a federal grant.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-15A-1 be repealed.
- 5 <u>13-15A-1. If the Department of Education receives a federal grant under the American</u>
- 6 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Division A, Section 14006, Pub. L. No. 111-5 as
- 7 amended to January 1, 2010, the department shall initiate a pilot charter school primarily for
- 8 American Indian students from federally recognized tribes that is infused with cultural activities.
- 9 The curriculum of the school shall emphasize science, technology, engineering, and
- 10 mathematics as well as American Indian culture.
- 11 Section 2. That §§ 13-15A-2 to 13-15A-10, inclusive, be repealed.
