- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require schools to provide instruction on certain
- 2 historical documents and speeches.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-33-4 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 13-33-4. In all public and nonpublic schools located within the state there shall be given
- 6 regular courses of instruction in the Constitutions of the United States and the State of South
- 7 Dakota, the Declaration of Independence, the Emancipation Proclamation, the Gettysburg
- 8 Address, substantive selections from the Federalist Papers, and President George Washington's
- 9 farewell address. Such instruction shall begin not later than the opening of the eighth grade and
- shall continue in the high school to an extent to be determined by the South Dakota Board of
- 11 Education.
