- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions related
- 2 to trade regulation of petroleum products.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 37-2-11 be repealed.
- 5 37-2-11. No person shall display any sign, label, or other designating mark which describes
- 6 any lubricating oil or gasoline for internal combustion engines not actually sold or offered for
- sale or delivered at the location at which the sign, label, or other designating mark is displayed,
- 8 or display any label upon any container which label names or describes any lubricating oil or
- 9 gasoline for internal combustion engines not actually contained therein, but offered for sale or
- 10 sold as such.
