## HOUSE BILL NO. 1175

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt certain sales of goods and services by minors
- 2 from the sales tax.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 10-45 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 The provisions of this chapter do not apply to the gross receipts from any casual or
- 6 occasional sale of goods or services made by any person who is under eighteen years of age. For
- 7 the purposes of this section, the term, casual or occasional sale of goods or services, means that
- 8 the seller's gross revenue from the sale of tangible personal property, any product transferred
- 9 electronically, or services delivered into South Dakota is less than one thousand dollars in any
- 10 calendar year.
