- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require the Department of Social Services to submit an
- 2 implementation plan to allow the state to issue photo EBT cards.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- In order to allow the State of South Dakota to begin issuing photo Electronic Benefit
- 6 Transfer (EBT) cards, the Department of Social Services shall submit to the Food and Nutrition
- 7 Service of the United States Department of Agriculture a comprehensive implementation plan.
- 8 The plan shall address certain operational issues to ensure that the state's implementation of
- 9 photo EBT cards is consistent with all the federal requirements and that program access is
- 10 protected for participating households.
- The plan shall demonstrate that the state is meeting performance standards in the
- supplemental nutrition assistance program and include established procedures to ensure that any
- appropriate member of a household or authorized representative, who is not pictured on the
- photo EBT card, may use the card. Furthermore, the department shall, within the plan, clearly

1 provide that, once implemented, the photo EBT card requirement will be a function of issuance

- 2 and will not affect any household's eligibility or the certification process.
- The department shall submit the plan no later than December 31, 2017.
