- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for the acceptance of more than one bid for the
- 2 provision of certain services to cities or counties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 5-18A be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:

Notwithstanding any other more general provision in this chapter, whenever a city or county receives more than one bid to provide towing, storage, cleanup, or any other recurring shortterm, low-cost services which are ordered by the city or county, but are not paid for by the city or county, if any or all of the bids provide for an equivalent quality of service at substantially the same cost, the city or county shall accept all such bids and shall rotate utilization of services among the successful bidders in such manner as is likely to provide each successful bidder with a proportional share of the total calls for the services to be provided.
