- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to declare the fourth Saturday in July Day of the American
- 2 Cowboy.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 1-5 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- The fourth Saturday of July shall be known as Day of the American Cowboy. Day of the
- 7 American Cowboy is dedicated to the protection, preservation, and promotion of the cowboy
- 8 and Western heritage of the State of South Dakota, and honoring cowboys and cowgirls for their
- 9 enduring contribution to the courageous, pioneering spirit of America. In keeping with the hard-
- riding work ethic of cowboys, the Day of the American Cowboy is a working holiday.
