- 1 An Act to limit public employer consideration of certain criminal backgrounds.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

3-6C-27. Public employment--Consideration of criminal record—Public employer defined.

A public employer may not inquire into or consider the criminal record or criminal history of an applicant for public employment until the applicant has been selected for an interview by the employer.

This section does not apply to the Department of Corrections or to a public employer that has a statutory duty to conduct a criminal history background check or otherwise take into consideration a potential employee's criminal history during the hiring process. This section does not prohibit a public employer from notifying an applicant that law or the employer's policy will disqualify an applicant with a particular criminal history background from employment in particular positions.

As used in this section, the term, public employer, means the state or a political subdivision. The term does not include a school district.
