## HOUSE BILL NO. 1190

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Office of the Governor

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation for community-based provider 2 workforce improvement and to declare an emergency. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. The moneys appropriated in this Act shall be allocated to community-based 5 providers throughout South Dakota to enhance the providers' ability to hire and retain direct care 6 staff within their facilities located in South Dakota. 7 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of two million nine 8 hundred twenty-six thousand seven hundred thirty-two dollars (\$2,926,732), and the sum of one 9 million eight hundred sixty-three thousand one hundred ninety dollars (\$1,863,190) in federal 10 fund expenditure authority, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Social 11 Services for the purpose described in section 1 of this Act. 12 Section 3. The secretary of the Department of Social Services shall approve vouchers and 13 the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized in section 2 of this Act. 14 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one million forty-15 one thousand two hundred forty dollars (\$1,041,240), and the sum of one million forty-one

thousand four hundred eleven dollars (\$1,041,411) in federal fund expenditure authority, or so

- 2 much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Human Services for the purpose
- 3 described in section 1 of this Act.
- 4 Section 5. The secretary of the Department of Human Services shall approve vouchers and
- 5 the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized in section 4 of this Act.
- 6 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred fifty-
- 7 seven thousand twenty-eight dollars (\$157,028), and the sum of seventy-nine thousand seven
- 8 hundred ninety-one dollars (\$79,791) in federal fund expenditure authority, or so much thereof
- 9 as may be necessary, to the Department of Corrections for the purpose described in section 1
- of this Act.
- Section 7. The secretary of the Department of Corrections shall approve vouchers and the
- state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized in section 6 of this Act.
- Section 8. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- Section 9. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
