1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation for community-based provider  
2 workforce improvement and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The moneys appropriated in this Act shall be allocated to community-based  
5 providers throughout South Dakota to enhance the providers' ability to hire and retain direct care  
6 staff within their facilities located in South Dakota.

7 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one million five  
8 hundred sixty thousand five hundred twenty dollars (\$1,560,520), and the sum of four hundred  
9 four thousand three hundred twelve dollars (\$404,312) in federal fund expenditure authority,  
10 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Social Services for the purpose  
11 described in section 1 of this Act.

12 Section 3. The secretary of the Department of Social Services shall approve vouchers and  
13 the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized in section 2 of this Act.

14 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one million forty-  
15 one thousand two hundred forty dollars (\$1,041,240), and the sum of one million forty-one



1 thousand four hundred eleven dollars (\$1,041,411) in federal fund expenditure authority, or so  
2 much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Human Services for the purpose  
3 described in section 1 of this Act.

4 Section 5. The secretary of the Department of Human Services shall approve vouchers and  
5 the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized in section 4 of this Act.

6 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred fifty-  
7 seven thousand twenty-eight dollars (\$157,028), and the sum of seventy-nine thousand seven  
8 hundred ninety-one dollars (\$79,791) in federal fund expenditure authority, or so much thereof  
9 as may be necessary, to the Department of Corrections for the purpose described in section 1  
10 of this Act.

11 Section 7. The secretary of the Department of Corrections shall approve vouchers and the  
12 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized in section 6 of this Act.

13 Section 8. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall  
14 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

15 Section 9. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its  
16 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in  
17 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
