- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow certain students to be excused from participating
- 2 in certain assessments, examinations, and tests.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-3 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law or administrative rule, a parent or guardian
- of a student enrolled in a public school may refuse to allow the student to participate in any
- 7 assessment, examination, or test that is not administered solely for the use of an individual
- 8 classroom teacher.
- 9 The assessments, examinations, and tests from which a student may be excused pursuant to
- this section include the following:
- 11 (1) Any statewide assessments required pursuant to § 13-3-55;
- 12 (2) Any benchmark examination;
- 13 (3) Any pre-assessment or post-assessment connected to student learning objectives or
- any assessment mandated by the Governor's office;
- 15 (4) Any milestone testing;

- 1 (5) Any progress-monitoring or response-to-intervention assessment;
- 2 (6) Any online assessment system or adaptive testing done in a computer laboratory;
- 3 (7) Any exam used to formulate an evaluation or score for a student's teacher or school;

- 5 (8) Any survey, electronic or paper, that is not designed by the student's teacher for use
- 6 in classroom instruction.
