- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide access to abandoned cemeteries and private
- 2 burying grounds.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 Any owner of private property on which a cemetery or grave is located shall allow ingress
- 6 and egress to the cemetery or grave for purposes of basic lawn care, replacing and repairing of
- 7 fences, corrective measures relative to grave markers, and visitation of graves. This right of
- 8 access to the cemetery or grave extends for visitation or maintenance during reasonable hours,
- 9 after obtaining consent of the landowner. No landowner may unreasonably withhold consent.
- 10 The landowner shall designate the route for reasonable access.
- 11 Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 12 A person entering private property to access a cemetery or grave under this Act is liable to
- 13 the owner of the property for any damage caused as a result of the person's access.

- 1 Section 3. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 2 A person denied reasonable access may bring an action in circuit court, where the property
- 3 is located, to enjoin the owner of the property from denying the person reasonable ingress and
- 4 egress to the cemetery or grave.
