## HOUSE BILL NO. 1203

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow school districts, for a period of two years, to
- 2 transfer funds from the capital outlay fund to the general fund under certain circumstances.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-16 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- Notwithstanding the provisions of § 13-16-26, if the per student allocation as defined in
- 7 § 13-13-10.1 for the current school fiscal year is less than the per student allocation for the
- 8 previous school fiscal year, a school district may transfer all or any part of a surplus from the
- 9 capital outlay fund to the general fund. However, the amount transferred pursuant to this section
- in any school fiscal year may not exceed an amount equal to the difference between the previous
- school fiscal year's per student allocation and the current school fiscal year's per student
- allocation multiplied by the current fall enrollment of the school district.
- 13 Section 2. The provisions of this Act are repealed on June 30, 2013.
