## HOUSE BILL NO. 1209

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for reimbursement of property taxes paid on
- 2 certain private lands inundated by the waters of nonmeandered lakes.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 41-2 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 The Department of Game, Fish and Parks shall reimburse the property owner for any
- 7 property taxes paid by the property owner after the effective date of this Act on any agricultural
- 8 land that, at the time the taxes were due and payable, was inundated by the public waters of a
- 9 nonmeandered lake and was not farmable. To receive reimbursement under this Act, the
- property owner shall apply to the department and shall provide a copy of the application to the
- director of equalization of the county in which the taxable inundated lands are located. The
- department shall consult with the director of equalization to verify that the agricultural lands
- were inundated and not farmable and to determine the amount of the reimbursement. Upon
- verification, the department shall reimburse the property owner from money in the Department

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- of Game, Fish and Parks fund. The Game, Fish and Parks Commission shall promulgate rules
- 2 pursuant to chapter 1-26 to specify forms, procedures, and requirements to apply for and receive
- 3 reimbursement.
- 4 Any person who applies for or receives a reimbursement under this Act by misrepresenting
- 5 the facts as to the person's ownership of the property, the amount of inundated property, or other
- 6 related information shall be assessed a penalty equal to ten dollars per thousand dollars of
- 7 valuation on the subject property, which shall become a perpetual lien on the property pursuant
- 8 to § 10-21-33. Any such person shall be barred from receiving any reimbursement under this
- 9 Act for the following three years.
