House Bill 1215

Introduced by: Representative Randolph

1 An Act to prohibit the state from endorsing or enforcing certain policies regarding domestic relations.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:
- 5 **25-11-1. Marriage policies--Prohibitions.**
 - The state may not enforce, endorse, or favor policies that:
 - (1) Permit any form of marriage that does not involve a man and a woman;
 - (2) Appropriate benefits to persons who enter a marriage other than a marriage involving a man and a woman;
- 10 (3) Permit counties to issue marriage licenses to persons other than for a marriage
 11 involving a man and a woman;
- 12 <u>(4) Treat sexual orientation as a suspect class or as a basis of prohibited</u>
 13 <u>discrimination;</u>
 - (5) Recognize a person's belief that that person was born a gender that does not accord with the biological sex of the person as determined by that person's anatomy at birth;
 - (6) Appropriate tax dollars to pay for sex change operations;
- 18 (7) Ban conversion therapy. Under this subdivision, conversion therapy, means a
 19 therapeutic practice in which a licensed medical professional, acting under
 20 authorized consent, assists a client in the goal or realigning the client's sexual
 21 preference to prefer members of the opposite sex who have corresponding
 22 reproductive anatomy;
- 23 (8) Permit public libraries or public schools in the state to partner with nonsecular 24 organizations to promote, host, sponsor, favor, or endorse drag queen storytime;
- 25 (9) Mandate pronoun changes;

1	(10)	Condone or affirm homosexual, transgender, zoophilia, objectophilia, polygamy, or
2		sexual orientation doctrines; and
3	(11)	Permit a person to change the sex on a birth certificate to a sex that does not
4		accord with that person's anatomy at birth.
5 Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added:		
6	25	-11-2. Rights not affected by chapter.
7		This chapter does not affect:
8	(1)	Marriages between a man and a woman;
9	(2)	A person's right to set the person's self-asserted, sex-based identity narrative or
10		sexual orientation; and
11	(3)	A nerson's right to practice secular humanism
