House Bill 1215

An Act to require a study of radio communication services in the Piedmont Valley region and make an appropriation to perform the study and purchase digital vehicular repeater systems.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **Section 1.** The Department of Public Safety shall perform a study on radio communication
- 6 <u>services in the Piedmont Valley region, specifically to address gaps in radio coverage, network</u>
- 7 capacity, and migration to digital channels. Before June 30, 2025, the department shall issue
- 8 a report with recommendations to the Legislature of measures the department and agencies
- 9 in the Piedmont Valley can take to improve radio communication services in the area and
- 10 <u>ensure long-term, wide-ranging radio coverage.</u>
- 11 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$100,000 to the
- 12 <u>Department of Public Safety for performing the study described in section 1 of this Act.</u>
- 13 **Section 3.** There is also hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$250,000 to
- the Department of Public Safety to reimburse purchases of digital vehicular repeater systems
- 15 by the Meade County Sheriff's Office, Sturgis Police Department, Summerset Police
- 16 Department, Black Hawk Volunteer Fire Department, Piedmont Volunteer Fire Department,
- 17 Sturgis Volunteer Fire Department, and Sturgis Ambulance Service. The department shall
- 18 <u>establish an application process for reimbursement.</u>
- 19 **Section 4.** The secretary of the Department of Public Safety shall approve vouchers and the
- 20 <u>state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.</u>
- 21 **Section 5.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 23 **Section 6.** This Act is effective beginning June 30, 2024.
