## HOUSE BILL NO. 1219

Introduced by: Representatives Stricherz, Elliott, Jensen, Killer, Magstadt, Nelson (Stace), Tornow, and Willadsen and Senator Lederman

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to extend certain protections against precipitous eviction
- 2 to certain long-term tenants at will.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 43-8-8 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 43-8-8. A tenancy or other estate at will, however created, may be terminated by the
- 6 landlord's giving notice to the tenant in the manner prescribed by § 43-8-9 to remove from the
- 7 premises within a period, specified in the notice, of not less than one month. <u>However, if the</u>
- 8 tenancy at will is the residence of the tenant and the resident has resided at that residence for
- 9 twenty-four months or more, the tenant is entitled to two months' notice in the manner
- 10 prescribed by § 43-8-9 unless:
- 11 (1) The tenant has engaged in sustained conduct that is either disruptive to other
- 12 residents or neighbors, illegal, destructive, or negligent toward the maintenance of
- 13 the property, or constitutes a material breech in the implied lease conditions; or
- 14 (2) The landlord has sold the property or the property has passed to the landlord's estate.
- 15 Section 2. That chapter 43-8 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as

1 follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 of this Act, if the tenancy at will is the residence
of a tenant who is on active military service or if a person on active military service is an
immediate family member of the tenant, the tenant is entitled to ninety days notice in the manner
prescribed in § 43-8-9.
